



What parents can do to help keep us all safe

Attendance

If your child has any of the symptoms such as a high temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss of or change to their sense of smell or taste or just seems unwell please do not bring your child into the setting.

Children can only attend the setting if they are symptom free or have completed the required isolation period.

Symptoms or confirmed cases of COVID-19

In the event a child develops symptoms whilst attending the setting, they will have to be collected as soon as possible. Whilst waiting for the child to be collected they will be isolated from others. A facemask will be worn by staff member isolating with them if a distance of 2 metres cannot be maintained. If contact is necessary, gloves, apron and facemask will be worn. i.e. if they are sick. A window will be opened for ventilation.

If a child or member of staff develops symptoms they will be asked to go and get tested. All children and staff in that group will be sent home and asked to isolate for 7 days or until the test is confirmed negative. Where a child or staff member tests positive, the group will be advised to self-isolate for 14 days.

If your child becomes unwell at home with symptoms please call Tina on 07956004363 immediately so that we can put our isolation measures in place and safeguard all other children and staff.

Physical Distancing

Only parents who are symptom free and or have completed the required isolation periods should drop off or collect their child.

One parent/carer per family should drop off or pick up their child. Our current collection policy is still in place and your child will only be released to a member of the family on our list. Any changes to this you will need to advise us in writing please.

Parents are required to drop off and pick up at the pre-school gate to avoid parents entering the setting unnecessarily.

When waiting to drop off or collect your child, please queue outside the pre-school gate maintaining a 2m distance at all times

Parents will not be permitted to enter the pre-school building to minimise contact between the parent and other children and staff members.

Travel

Wherever possible staff and parents should travel to the pre-school alone, using their own transport.

Parents will not be allowed to leave any travel accessories including buggies, car seats, scooter etc. on the setting premises.

Resources/cross contamination

Children should not bring items from home into the setting unless essential for their wellbeing. Where this is the case items will be appropriately cleaned upon arrival.

Please do not allow your child to bring in any toys from home at this time.

Please send your child in each day in clean clothes.

Please bring in a clearly named bottle of drink for your child each day. We will be able to refill these throughout the morning with milk or water.

The preschool must be kept updated of any changes to contact details and/or any allergy, medical and dietary information regarding your child. Please advise in writing if any of these have changed over the past 3 months.

At this time please do not bring in your child's home bags and contact books. Please communicate to us either through email, texts or the 2simple portal.
